Nature & Scope of Work This is skilled and semi-skilled work in the layout, cultivation, maintenance and repair of turf areas such as playing and sports fields, recreational areas and maintenance of all-weather fields. In addition, responsibility is entailed for participating in and supervising the work of subordinates engaged in playing field and recreational area installation, maintenance and repair tasks. The incumbent of this position works under minimal supervision and exercises considerable independent judgement and action. Work performance is reviewed by a superior in terms of condition of playing fields, sports and recreational areas.

Illustrative Examples of Work

- Lays out, cultivates, repairs and maintains turf areas such as playing and sports fields, and other recreational areas by seeding, irrigating, fertilizing and repairing turf-grass areas; maintains all-weather fields.
- Participates in and supervises the work of subordinates engaged in playing field and recreational area installation, maintenance and repair tasks.
- Prepares and maintains work records.
- Deals courteously and effectively with the public and user groups.
- Performs related work as required.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Thorough knowledge of the methods, practices, tools, materials and equipment used in the layout, maintenance and repair of playing fields, sports and recreational areas.
- Considerable knowledge of turf and grass horticulture related to the maintenance of playing fields, sports and recreational areas.
- Ability to prepare and maintain work records, and to read and interpret plans, sketches and blueprints.
- Ability to plan, check and supervise the work of subordinates.
- Ability to prepare and maintain turf and grass on fields and other areas.
- Ability to deal courteously with the public and user groups.
- Ability to perform work under minimal supervision.
- Skill in the use of tools and equipment used in the layout, development, maintenance and repair of sports and recreational fields.

Desirable Training & Completion of the 12th school grade supplemented by technical courses related to the work, preferably Experience completion of a diploma program in Turf Management, Sound experience in layout, construction and maintenance of playing fields, recreational and fine turf areas, or an equivalent combination of training and experience.
