**Nature & Scope of Work** This is diverse technical and mechanical work involving responsibility for the inspection, servicing, maintenance, repair and operation of sewer, water and drainage pumping stations, systems and equipment. An employee of this class inspects stations, performs scheduled maintenance and repairs, investigates malfunctions and complaints, takes required corrective action and supervises a small number of subordinates engaged in the less complex aspects of the work. Duties are performed with a high degree of independence of action and judgement with the more complex operational matters being discussed with a superior who reviews work performance in terms of effective technical, inspectional, operational and maintenance services rendered.

**Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities**

- Thorough knowledge of the standard practices, methods, tools and equipment used in the maintenance, repair, inspection and operation of a variety of water, sewer and drainage pumping stations and systems.
- Considerable knowledge of the hazards and proper safety precautions required in the work.
- Ability to inspect operations, diagnose and correct malfunctions and perform maintenance, repair and installation tasks on pumping equipment and systems.
- Ability to read and interpret meters and gauges, to requisition parts and materials and maintain and prepare reports and records related to the work.
- Ability to assign, check and supervise the work of one or more subordinates.
- Ability to understand and carry out written and oral instructions and perform all duties with minimal supervision.
- Skill in the use and care of tools and equipment essential in the repair, maintenance, installation and testing of a variety of pumps and related equipment.
- Mechanical aptitude.
- Working knowledge of computer applications including Microsoft Office and Delta's Scada system.

**Desirable Training & Experience** Completion of the 12th school grade supplemented by technical courses related to the work and considerable experience in pump maintenance and repair work or an equivalent combination of training and experience.
