When assistance is necessary, the incumbent will be responsible for assisting the crew for productivity and adherence to policy, procedures and standards.
	The incumbent must work in all types of weather conditions and be physically fit to perform heavy manual work in a variety of work situations. During inclement weather or when equipment operation assignments are not available, the incumbent will be required to perform other tasks as assigned by the supervisor.
	The incumbent must be skilled in the safe operation of a variety of pieces of equipment and must ensure tha all regulations pertaining to equipment operation are followed. An incumbent must have the ability to carry or written and oral instructions, have the ability to understand written procedures and manuals, and complete paperwork clearly and legibly. The work of the incumbent is reviewed by a supervisor for adherence to safe work procedures, productivity and conformance to acceptable standards and procedures. An incumbent receives advice and direction from a supervisor to sort out conflicting priorities and other non-routine issues.
	Candidates must possess previous construction and/or maintenance experience in a municipal environment specifically related to utility construction. Working knowledge of the tools, equipment, materials and construction methods in a municipal setting is required.
